PAPERWORK

Your children will bring home today an envelope with important paperwork for you to review and complete. The validation forms, aquatic consent and major excursion permission forms need to be completed and returned promptly to the office.

There is also forms for you to complete if you wish to pay your child/children's levies in installments. You do not need to complete these forms if you have already paid your levies or if you intend to pay them in full before the due date. Any questions regarding levies can be directed to Deb Lade, School Business Manager.

ASSEMBLIES

This year both Primary and Early Childhood assemblies will take place on Thursdays fortnightly starting next week. Early Childhood Assembly will be at 11.10am followed by the Primary Assembly at 11.50am

MEDICATION

If your child requires medication during school hours, an Administration of Medication Authorisation Form must be filled out. The form has two sides 'A' and 'B'. 'A' side must be filled out by a parent or guardian for all medication, including non-prescription medication such as Claratyne and Panadol. Side 'B' must be filled out by a Pharmacist or Doctor, if the medication is prescribed.

These forms need to be brought to the school office with the medication for safe keeping. Medication whether it is prescribed or not, can not be kept in student's school bags for safety reasons.

There are conditions that need to be met to enable us to administer medication to your child.

- We only accept prescribed in-date medication provided in the dispensed, labelled container, or the original overthe-counter packaging for non-prescribed medication.
- A Department of Education, Children and Young People Administration of Medication Authorisation Form is required for all medication – prescription and non-prescription. For prescription

medication this MUST be filled out by a medical practitioner, pharmacist or nurse. You can get this form from our school office.

As many medications are controlled pharmaceuticals, we ask that you do not send this medication on the bus with your child. To ensure it is transported in a safe and responsible manner, we ask that parent/guardians bring the medication out to the school to ensure it cannot be accessed by other students.

If your child has a medical condition, that we are unaware of and you believe we should be, please make an appointment with either your child's class teacher or Mrs Lauren Beams.
