During the past 9 weeks we have issued 7257 loans and renewals for staff and students.

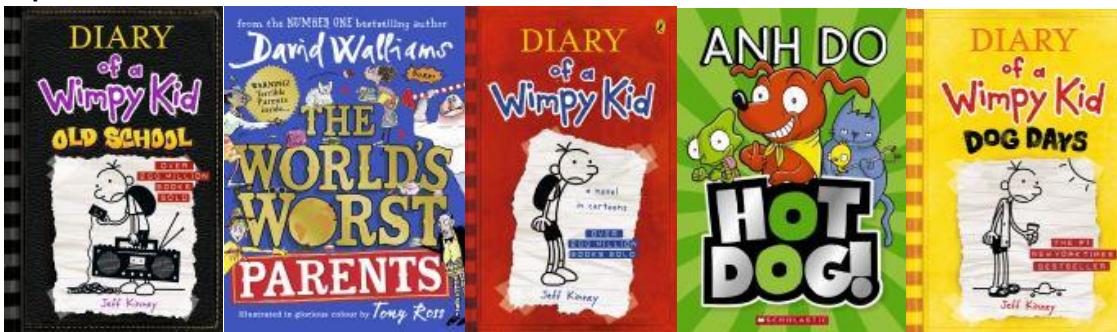

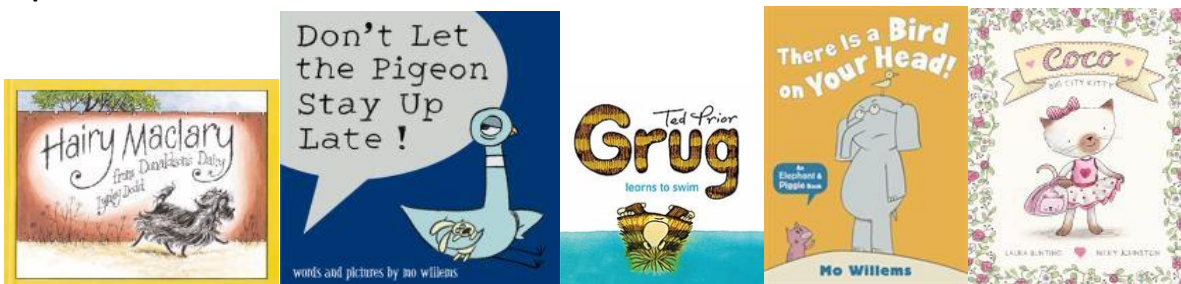
