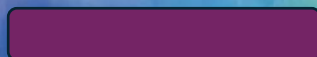
Colour Fun Run

Library Habits Awards

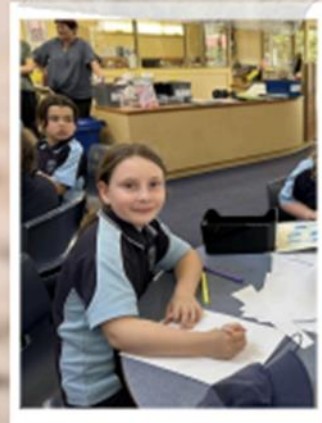


